Seed Swap Co-op Registration Form

Mission of the Ministry of Agriculture's Seed Swap Co-op- Encourage families to produce their own food through education and support on all agriculture, permaculture, small gardening methods and practices. Specifically focusing on acquiring heirloom seed diversity to better ensure pest and disease resilient crops without any GMO's or toxic sprays.

How this co-op works- All funds given by members are used to purchase an ounce or more of each heirloom variety vegetable or fruit seeds. Once seeds have shipped to the coordinator, the seeds will then be divided evenly by weight to each member. Depending the number of participants, you could receive between 30 seeds and 300 seeds per vegetable. The more sign ups the greater the variety of vegetables available.

Cost- Each member is to contribute \$60 usd. The cost covers, shipping, seed envelopes and heirloom seeds.

Result- You become part of a community working together to strengthen food security and receive a number of heirloom vegetable/fruit seeds.
